There were two negroes given & - which were put in the hands of Mr. Libbitt for the maintenance & - of the children for the year 1839. One died unfortunately in the Logan circuit court amongst the heirs of Mr. Horton deceased there was allotted to the said heirs of Jm. Horton the sum of \$150.00 that suit is now in the court of appeals, and a Super cedas has been granted, what the result yet will be cannot now be stated. Some negroes had been sold in that circuit & to the amount of \$150.00 came into my hands the five cents for sale but it is uncertain whether the said sum will be allotted to the
