 Rachel Donaldson two Horses & one steer to be at her dis-
 -posal & for her years I further give unto my wife two steers
 & four sheep to be for her years & the ballance to be divided
 amongst her children as she thinks most I also give unto my
 son William Donaldson my Riding saddle to be for his
 years I also give unto my son Andrew Donaldson my gun
 & two sheep to be for his years as Witness my hand &
 seal this the 21st day of December 1802
