 Madison County and State of Kentucky, now in the full
 enjoyment of my Reason and expecting shortly to leave this
 Transitory, would do in this last will and Testament
 consider it my duty to make the following of my goods
 and chattles, And first it is my will, that all my
 Just Ditts shall be paid, and then I give and bequeath
 all to my beloved wife Jane her bed and furniture
 two Cows and the Tatton Hays, the Horse I now
 live in with a Sufficient Maintainance for herself &
 stock during her life with every Article of Household
 furniture Necessary for her support, And I also give
 and bequeath unto my son Barnabas the Plantation
 I now live on, the Bay Horse, Also the Debt due
 from James Devier, Also the Debt from J. H. Hatten
 Also Twenty six pounds of the Debt due from Christ^o
 H and his Box and all my farming Utensils with
 all the Remaining part of the stock and he shall
 pay all my Ditts, I Also give and bequeath to
 Lather Kinder, daughter of my Daughter Jane Kinder
 twenty pounds of the Debt due from Christ^o H and, &
 if she dies under age the said twenty pounds to be
 given to her next child, I also give and bequeath to
 George Kinder all my entry of land on the north
 fork of Woodstock to him and his heirs forever, I also give
 and bequeath unto my son Robert Twenty eight pounds

376 of a Debt due from P. Davis in Lue of a Waggon
 Received of him Also twenty eight of a Debt due
 from D^r Miller to be divided equally Between
 him and John Curry, Also give unto bequeaths to my
 son William twenty Shillings cash, myson Barnabas
 is also to have his Rifle gun his Saddle boots &c In
 Witness hereof I shew set my hand and Seal this 16th
 day of May in the year of our Lord 1778th
