In the Name of god Amen I James Chizum of Madison County State of Kentucky being very sick in body but in perfect health of mind and memory thank to the Lord for it, calling to mind the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to die do make & Ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all I commend my Spirit unto the hands of Almighty god that give it and my body I recommend to the earth to be Buried in decent Christian Burial and as touching such Worldly Estate as it hath pleased god to bless me in this Word with I give devise and dispose of in the following manner and form first I give and bequeath to my Neice

Sarah K Williams five pounds Current Money of Kentucky provided ~~that~~ the Ball on my estate for nothing Likewise give and bequeath to William Hogan one set of French Plains and a bed Plain and a Ship'd Nankew Boat and three Coats shirts and my best hat I likewise give and bequeath to Sophia Strawhen one new chest that is not quite finished and I give and bequeath to John Wheeler one laden Bullard Boat two of my best shirts a pair of Boots & buckles my will is that the rest of my goods shall be sold at Publick Sale and the money put out at Interest and the Interest thence arising to be applied to use of my Mother as long as she lives After the death of my Mother my desire is that Thomas, John, Isaac, Wesley, Posey and Samuel Williams Sons & daughters of my Brother John Williams shall each of them have three pounds out of my Estate and my Will is that my Neice Mary Chambers shall ~~have~~ equally with the Others aforementioned Children the Remainder to be Equally Divided Between my Sister Martha Posey her daughter Delia Likewise Ordain constitute and appoint John Sappington and John Wheeler the executors of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this eight day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five

In the name of god Amen this twenty seventh day of Octo. 1795 I Thomas Maxwell of the State of Kentucky and County of Madison &c. in firm in body but of perfect mind &c. memory thanks to the all mighty god and calling to Remembrance the uncertain state of this transitory life and that all flesh must yield unto Death when it shall please god to call I do make constitute Ordain &c. declare this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following Revoking and Disanuling by this present a all and every testament and Testaments will &c. &c. heretofore by me made and declared either by word or Writing and this to be Taken only for my last will &c. Testament and none Other and first being penitent for my sins passed most humbly desiring forgiveness for the same I give and commit my soul unto Allmighty god my Saviour and Redeemer then my body to be decently buried and then for settling of my temporal Estate I do Order give and dispose the same in manner and form following first I will that my lawfull debts and contracts shall be well and truly paid in a convenient time after my decease by my executors here after mentioned Viz my wife Agnes Maxwell & my Oldest Son Bejabee Maxwell and Mag^r John and Terrell these I do make constitute &c. Ordain to be my executors Item I give to my loved wife her thirds of this place I now live on her life time likewise the household furniture &c. all my Personal Estate excepting such things as I have given them a all ready to be at their Disposal to dispose of to the Children as they grow up to the age that the Law requires as she thinks most proper with their advice of the Executors to furnish them as well as possible with Cloaths bedding
