Wiz. I promise my Desire that all my just Debt & Funeral
Expence shall be fully paid & Satisfied. Then I lend to
my beloved wife Sarah Robertson during her natural
life or widowhood the following Negro viz Gate Luce
Tob Elze and their increase, I also lend to my said wife
Sarah Robertson one horse & Saddle two Cows and Calves
during her or widowhood. Then I give and bequeath
unto my Daughter Anna Hawkins the one half of the
Negroes and their Increase that I got by my beloved
wife Sarah Robertson from her father Peyton Smith
also one Guinea to buy her a Mourning Ring after the death
of my wife Sarah Robertson to her and her heirs for ever
Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Dorothy
Pitman half the Negroes that I got by my wife Sarah
Robertson and their increase after the death of my wife
Sarah Robertson also one Guinea to buy her a mourning
Ring to her and her heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath to
my son Peyton Robertson a part of the tract of land
I now live on Beginning at the mouth of the Linn
River Branch thence up the Branch to the first fork
thence up the ^{left} hand fork twelve poles from thence
North to my line to Include all my land on the west
side of said Branch also a likely Sorel mare and her
Increase the mare now in his possession also Fifty pounds to be
paid by my son William Robertson out of his part of the
Estate to make Peyton Robertson part of the land Equal to
William Robertson on the east side of the branch to him &
his heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath unto my son
