Then at her death I will that all my Children that is now small shall have a Share equal to my other Children that is grown at present then the Ballance I will to be equally Divided amongst all my Children A.D. I will and bequeath to my son Dudley Faris the three head of horses which he now claims then I will and bequeath to my son Jager Faris two head that he now claims then I will and bequeath to my son R^d Faris in two years old filly that he now claims then I will and bequeath this to be my last will and Testament written this 27th day of October 1799.
