This Inventory and Appraisement of the Estate of William Lee Deceased, was Returned and ordered to be Recorded

In the Name of God amen. I Andrew Elder a citizen of Kentucky and County of Madison do make acknowledgment and declare this Instrument of writing to be my last will and Testament, revoking all others. Impressing all my debts of which there are but few, and none of Magnitude are to be paid and the Leggers herein after bequeathed are to be

426 discharged as soon as circumstances will permit, and in the manner directed - Item to my eldest son John Elder I give and bequeath the land on which he now lives lying on the East end of my Survey and running West to include his Improvement terminated by a line beginning at Gilberts line on the South and running to join the said Gilberts line on the North. Parallel with the said John Elders Orchard supposed to be one hundred acres be the same more or less.

Item To my Daughter Leahy Hudson I give and bequeath one cow - Item To my youngest son Alexander Elder and my daughter Polly Elder I give and bequeath the land on which I now live, a line of division to be a stream known by the name of Headers Branch, Alexander to have the farm and dwelling house likewise the said Polly is to have her saddle and a Horse and two one feather bed, bedcloaths and one cow.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy M. Hunt one bed and one small Horse etc.

Item I give and bequeath to my grandson Andrew Elder, son of Mathew Elder, one cow.

Item To my dear and beloved wife Margaret Elder I give and bequeath the use profit and benefit of my remaining estate real and personal for the term of natural life my negroes and stock of all kinds, horses, cows etc. I give to her and her heirs forever, as I also do my household and kitchen furniture to be used and disposed of as she may think proper, she is also to have her living on the land

427 bequeathed to my son Alexander Elder I appoint as Executors & Executrices to this my last Will and Testament Mathew Elder and Margaret my wife In Witness whereof I put my hand and seal this 16th day of April in the year hundred and four
