And I do hereby constitute and appoint and appoint my wife and said two friends William Campbell and John S. Beach Executors of this my last will and Testament I do hereby revoke and disannul all former wills made or supposed to be made by me and do publish and declare this to be my only true last will and Testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
