to my wife as it may appear she may stand in need It is my will
and desire that Mariah and her children to remain in the hands
of my Beloved wife her life time and likewise my negro boy Gilester
I Appoint James Dumarice Sen^r Thomas Bell and Joseph
Barnett Executors to execute this my last will and Testament
