of Madison County and State of Kentucky being awake
in body but of a sound and disposing mind do
make this my last will and Testament first I wish
all my Just Debts paid Second I wish my wife Catharine
Stanton to have the use of all my House hold and kitchen
furniture during her life and I wish my wife Catharine
Stanton to have possession of my house during her life
and all the benefit arising from the Rent of my Land
Third I wish my wife to have all my Stock of Horses
except one Saddle Horse and all my Stock of Cattle except
one cow and calf and I wish my wife to have all my
Stock of Hogs to enjoy the benefit during her life with
exception that is not to have more of this property
fourth I wish Clinton bid to have one Saddle Horse
now in his possession fifth I wish Suckley & sons to
have one cow and calf when she becomes of age sixth
It is my desire that Clinton bid has all my Land
and all the property remaining in my wife's hands at
her death seventh it is my desire that John Hammon my

Executor to this my will It is my desire that Simon Mutton
have half of my wheat now growing given under my hand and
Seal this 26th of March 1816
