body to be buried by my Executors in a christian

as it hath pleased God to bless and endow me with

Barton one Shilling Sterling and no more, Item
I give and bequeath unto my Son Richard Oldham
one Shilling Sterling and no more, Item I give and
bequeath unto my ~~son~~ Daughter Mary Ann and George
one Shilling Sterling and no more, Item I give
and bequeath unto my Daughter Emma Harris one
Shilling Sterling and no more, Item I give and
bequeath unto my Son Thos Oldham fifty pounds
Kentucky currency and no more, Item I give and
bequeath unto my daughter Francis Oldham one
Shilling Sterling and no more Item I give and
bequeath unto my Daughter Sally Oldham Barton
one Shilling Sterling and no more.

My will and desire is that Jesse Oldham Elias Oldham
Betsy Oldham Nathaniel Oldham John H Oldham
these five last mentioned Children shall have all the
residue of my estate to be Equally Divided amongst them
both real & personal estate to my will.

Lastly I appoint my Son Jesse Oldham and my Son
Nathaniel Oldham my sole & sole Executors of this my
