 do therefore make and declare this my last will and testament.
 First My desire is that all my lawful debts be paid - Second I
 will and bequeath unto my loving wife Elizabeth Jodel all my
 land And house and all belonging to and on said land that is
 all my house hold and kitchen furniture and all my stock of every
 kind during her life. Third I will and bequeath after the death
 of my wife one hundred dollars to her Jodel son of my brother
 Joseph Jodel of the then remaining estate.

Fourth I will and bequeath after the death of my wife and
 dollar to each and every one of my brother and sister children.
 Then - Fifth I will and bequeath the balance of the said
 estate after the death of my wife, to Joseph Allen son
 of John and Nancy Allen died to him and his heirs
 forever, but if he shall die before he shall marry then my will
 is that it shall be equally divided between each of my brother
 and sister children. And I appoint my loving friend John Meagle
 and John Fells Executors of this my last will and testament.
