In the name of Our Almighty God and I John Sumner of Madison County and State of Kentucky being deeply impressed with the thought of the uncertainty of life have made this my last will and Testament I give to my wife and well beloved wife Mary Ann Sumner every thing that shall be found in my possession or that may be obtained by ^{me} ~~me~~ only my son named by paying my lawfull debts John Sumner my dear son is to have if he or his guardian shall choose ^{and all} ~~or~~ ^{my wife and pay all of her debts} ~~or~~ ^{the money} that is now called his property by paying her two dollars to George Moore and to my daughter Milly Shivers I give a two Dollar Cow and also I give her husband Reuben Shivers my share which I consider will make my son John and daughter Milly equal with my other lawfull heirs (viz) John Sumner and Mary Moore.

After my wife dies my will that John Sumner and John Sumner my two sons shall have my land and all the plantation trees that may be found in her possession each to have one half by paying each share my grand
