In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one
I Charles Roberts of Madison County and State of Kentucky being afflicted
with a disease of Body but possessed of a sound mind and memory
but knowing that I am appointed for all time over to die I wish therefore
to dispose of my worldly estate in the following manner First of
all I wish all my just debts paid. Secondly my will is that my beloved
wife Molly have all the negroes that belong to me at this time and their
increase together with all my land which I possess and all my farming tools
for her own use until all my children shall have arrived to the age of
twenty and young old. Also I give unto my wife and share with me
year old last spring. Thirdly I wish unto my daughter Nancy fifty
dollars to be paid out of my estate in due settling. I also may have mine
Fourthly I will unto my wife the sum of fifty dollars paid in the
same like manner. Fifthly I will unto my son John the sum of
fifty dollars paid in the same manner. Sixthly I will unto my son
Nathan fifty dollars to be paid in the same manner. Seventhly my
wife and I desire to have my wife and I before any of my children
shall arrive to the age of twenty and young old then and in that case I
wish all my estate both real and personal to be sold on a public
monthly estate and to be equally divided between all my sons and
daughters. And again my will is that should my wife and I die
my youngest children should have arrive to the age of twenty and
years then my will is that all my estate then remaining should be
sold on a public month estate and equally divided between all
my children, excepting one third part for my land including the
dwelling house and my negro woman Rebecca and all her increase
then I will to my wife. Lastly during her natural life, and
after her death to be sold and equally divided between all my
children. So having signed these at my hands and seal this

In the name of God. I, Thomas Turner, of the County of Madison and State of Kentucky, do make, ordain and declare this instrument to be my last will and testament, nothing doubting by no means. First, I give to my just debts to be punctually paid annually by my two younger sons, Thomas and Benjamin, my tract of land on which I now live to be equally divided between them among several - I also give to my son Thomas Turner, my Negro Boy, Frank and one feather Bed and furniture, and that he should keep the horse, and saddle and bridle that he now claims. Also I give to my daughter, Dannah Turner, my Negro girl Betty a cow and calf, a feather Bed and furniture, a side saddle and bridle to be worth between dollars - Also I give to my daughter, Nancy Turner, my Negro girl Rach, a feather bed and furniture, cow and calf, and saddle and bridle to be worth between dollars - Also I give to my son Benjamin Turner, my Negro boy Solomon, one horse saddle and bridle to be worth one hundred dollars, and my feather Bed and furniture, and that he shall be educated out of my Estate, to read, write and cipher as far as the double rule of three, and also to be comfortably clothed, and board while getting his education. The rest residue and remainder of my Estate, both real and personal, by my wish and desire for it to be sold and divided equally among all my children (viz), Benjamin Turner, Dannah Turner, Nancy Turner, Thomas Turner, Benjamin Turner, and the heirs of Dannah Turner, Thomas Turner and Benjamin Turner, to them and their heirs forever, but should either of the four last named children die before the arrival of his full age, or have an issue the portion that is left to them shall be divided to be sold and equally divided between all my children Betty, Dannah, and myself my son Edward Turner, and my brother Philip Turner, Executor of this my last will and testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th day of October, one thousand eight hundred and eleven in presence of David Brind, Clerk.
