

Item (3rd) I bequeath to my daughter Sally Harvey a negro girl named Sally, and father had with her about 15 shillings also one black horse etc.

Item (4th) All my Real and personal Estate except that before mentioned shall be sold and divided equally between my children the two girls above mentioned with the rest of the children Item (5th) I appoint John M. Bond and John M. Bond my executors of this my last Will and Testament.

In witness of all, and each of the things herein contained I have at my hand and seal this 6th day of December 1820

I John Collier of the County of Madison and Commonwealth of Kentucky being of a sound mind and perfect memory do constitute and make this my last Will and Testament revoking all others first of which I cannot say to be the last and in full to God who made it, 20th of April 1821. It is my Will and desire that all my just debts be punctually paid and faithfully discharged fully before and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Harvey the full and sole and exclusive privilege of me and my estate, things belonging to be disposed of at her discretion, and also she is to enjoy and enjoy one equal third of all my property hereditamentally and appurtenances of all debts due and owing to the last before mentioned excepted, during her natural life and after her death to be disposed of by her heirs (mentioned fully as for the heirs of my son James Harvey, Sally M. Bond and Elizabeth M. Bond having heretofore given their property to the amount of their share, that they shall only receive the sum of one dollar each to be paid by my executor hereafter named when called upon, and as for my daughter Sally Todd wife of John Todd, I having given her the Daisy her share as negro only give her one dollar to be paid by my executor when called upon, and as for

the balance of my Estate it is to be equally divided between my son John Collier and my daughter Lucy Henderson, after Joseph Henderson the said Lucy's husband, shall receive fifty dollars, it being the one half share (money paid to John Todd, and also the one third left to my wife Elizabeth, after her death is also to be equally divided between my son John and my daughter Lucy aforesaid, my son John Collier has fully received property to the amount of fifty two and a half dollars which is to be considered as so much of his part paid him, and accounted for in his settlement with his sister Lucy aforesaid, I have named and appointed my dearly beloved wife Elizabeth my executrix and Joseph Henderson my son in law Executor to this my last Will and Testament Given under my hand and seal this 30th day of February 1820
