

In pursuance of an order of the Madison County Court at their first February term appointing Commissioners to sell Francis Halley widow of Francis Halley and his third of the personal estate of said dead we met at the dwelling house of said Francis Halley on the 31st day of March 1820 and being first sworn we made the following settlement in kind and report the same as follows viz
