Agreeable to an order of the Honorable Macomb County Court to my attorney the undersigned being first duly sworn to attest to & certify her dower of her deceased husband's estate as follows to-wit: One hundred and eleven acres of land and townships 23. Beginning at two spears at the mouth of Davis Branch thence up the meanders of said Branch 146 or 5 poles thence S 26° 10' 0" polished thence S 41° 02' 30" to a stake at the mouth of Davis land thence S 50° 02' 00" to an Elm on the big branch and corner to Emory Davis thence up the meanders of said Branch 226.61 poles to three bushes near the mouth of a Branch thence up the meanders of said Branch or 896.24 poles thence S 77° 50' 00" poles thence South 59° 02' 30" poles to a corner to the Lewis Beck thence North her line or 726.5 poles to a white oak not found thence S 20° 02' 30" poles to a stake thence or 356.44 poles to the river near the mouth of said branch across said river with its several meanders or 9410.84 to the Beginning.
