 Recorded and the same has been done accordingly.

The obedience has been of the Madison County Court made
 at this Court term 1820 appointing the most worthy
 John Hawking and William McLeod from mefferson to
 settle with Richard Lewis and Betty Lewis heirs of Robert
 Lewis decd and Report the debts and assets the said
 commissioners met at the clerk's office in Madison County on
 the 5th day of December the 5th 1820 and having been first sworn
 and Richard Lewis one of said heirs being present we
 proceeded in said business and Report as follows to wit

The administrators of said estate being sworn as
 to amount of your honor as reported by John Hawking
 William McLeod and John Hawking the former
 from mefferson appointed by said Court and which
 report was made on the 7th day of August 1818 have
 returned which report only included the personal
 property sold by the administrators and the charges
 against the estate except to that time

To five negroes one woman two boys & two girls
 appraised by the term of \$1070.
 none of which negroes were named in the appraisement except a boy & a girl

Appraisement of the 3 boys and the two girls were sold by the
 Sheriff of Madison County in favour of Nicholas Brown
 against said administrators and sold together for the sum of \$336.00
 more than they were appraised to which was the commissioners
 conceive the administrators are properly chargeable with
