Also I give to my daughter, Nancy Turner, my Negro girl Rach, a feather bed and furniture, cow and calf, and saddle and bridle to be worth sixteen dollars. Also I give to my son Benjamin, Turner, my Negro Boy Solomon, one horse saddle and bridle to be worth one hundred dollars and my feather bed and furniture, and that he shall be educated out of my estate, to read, write and cipher as far as the double rule of three, and also to be comfortably clothed, and board and while getting his education. The real residue and remainder of my estate both real and personal, by my wish and desire, for it to be sold and divided equally among all my children (viz) Samy, Edward, Rachel, Mary, George, Turner, John, and David, each to have one share.
