In the name of Jesus I James Robertson of
Madison County and State of Kentucky being in the
State of Kentucky and swearing that I must truly
weigh this mortal body to the best and being of
sound mind and memory to perfect sense and
judgement do make this my last will & testament
I will give and bequeath my seal to you to give
them of unto my body to the earth from whence it may
take you according to heres

And as much as I have heretofore given to my daughter
James Robertson and negro by the name of Freeman
and Thomas Robertson and negro by the name of Miller
and to my daughter Elizabeth Hulme and negro by the
name of Charles and to my daughter Anna Hulme
and negro girl by the name of Freeman I conceive
that I have given them their full & just share of
my estate

It is my will and desire that during my life remain
but to give at my death to my daughter Anna
according to her own pleasure forever & give and bequeath
to my daughter Anna a spinning wheel and a
loom suited to her proper service

to give and bequeath herein a negro named to my
daughter Patience Dooly & her heirs forever

to give and bequeath to my daughter Patsy Dooly & her
heirs a negro man by the name of Davis

to give and bequeath to my son George Robertson and
his heirs forever a negro man by the name of Bill

to my will and desire that my slaves furnished
be sold and my just debts paid with the money
and all thing relating my self above that the rest of the
same be equally divided between my daughters Patience
and Anna Dooly to Patsy Dooly as my law

It is my last will and testament that those my children
mention'd children and their heirs shall peacefully possess
and enjoy the within bequeathed property forever
Having given and bequeathed my whole estate to my children
and the manner and form within mentioned I
have nominate constituted and appointed my daughter
Patience Dooly my true and lawful Executor to the
my last will and testament whenever I shall my
hand and affix my seal this the 6 day of January
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
twelve
