I give and bequeath to my daughter Phoebe Bailey & her  
 being a negroman by the name of David

I give and bequeath to my son Benj. Robertson and  
 his being forever and negro man by the name of Bill

It is my will and desire that my house furniture  
 be sold and a my just debts paid with the money  
 and any thing remaining over I give and bequeath to my  
 daughter Phoebe Bailey and my son Benj. Robertson

It is my last will and testament that should my within  
 mentioned children and their heirs shall peacefully possess  
 and enjoy the within bequeathed property forever  
 Having given and bequeathed my whole estate to my children  
 and in the manner and as forms within mentioned I  
 have nominated constituted and appointed my daughter  
 Patience Jags my true and lawful executor to my
