At a County Court held for Madison County on Monday the 6th day of October 1838 This Court with Thomas C. Howard as adm^r of David L. Irvine dec^d and as Guardian of the estate of said deceased was returned and ordered to be recorded and the same has been done accordingly.

I John Blay declare the following to be my last will & Testament hereby revoking all others by me made.

I give to my son Stanley Payne Blay and his heirs forever the tract of land on which he lives in the county of Bourbon containing 120 7/8 acres on this condition that he make up to my son Brutus paying other land out of the partnership land, equal to that tract, otherwise it must be equally divided between him & Brutus.

I give to my son Stanley P. Blay & to his heirs forever the following named slaves and their increase from this time to wit: William, Sue, Bob, Abelle, Luke, & black.

I give to my two sons Stanley P. Blay & Brutus L. Blay and to their heirs forever all my land in the county of Etowah to be equally divided between them, except a 200 acre tract on each side of Brown's creek lying partly in Etowah & Madison County, where Mills & Darbin now live.

I give to my son Stanley Payne Blay as a trustee the fee simple upon the following tract, the following named slaves, to wit: Aaron, his wife Mary, Gordon, Haley, Margaret, John, John, Peter, Dick, & William, that he permit my son Brutus during his life the use of profits, labour & services of said slaves during his life and at his death to convey the title of said slaves & their increase to the children of Brutus. That should my sons Brutus die without issue they shall be conveyed to my children and to the issue of them that may be then dead by death.
