It will be seen from the will of John Miller that his negroes were
 not to be divided agreeable to his will as therein directed without a sale.
 Garland Miller and a Francis Miller being infants under the age
 of 21 years Major John Harris & Christopher Brown were called on to
 value the negroes and to allot to them each one their number of
 negroes as specified in the will which they accordingly did
 allotting to Garland Miller two negroes boys named Alexander & Miley
 and to Francis Miller one negro woman named Peggy and her two
 children Riley Edmund and Annied which negroes agreeable
 to the calculations of said John Harris and Christopher Brown
 averaged \$225.37 for each than or negro agreeable to the will
 The balance of the negroes being number seven thus set up to the
 highest bidder and sold among the balance of the legacies only
