It is my will that my Executor hereafter named make sale of my personal property and after paying my debts out of the proceeds of the sale, the balance I leave and bequeath unto my wife Betty Pearson and my youngest child that she is now pregnant with that is to them or the survivor of them - In the second place - It is my will and desire that my wife Betty Pearson and my said child and do bequeath unto them all my estate both real and personal including the house and lot on which I now live and to be owned and used by them during their lives. If my wife should die before my said child then I will and bequeath unto my said child and do hereunto all my estate both real and personal as above described, and if my wife should not have a living child -
