Sale of a negro woman and two children sold to H. M. Mahan
about the 1st day of Decr 1826 for five hundred dollars which
with interest to this time amounts to four hundred and
seventy dollars which sum is in his hands the paper marked D.

6th For the above sales we find the admr Reid indebted \$16.26
to the estate the sum of \$16.26

also for payments made to us as 4.00

The admr William's estate is indebted \$146.15
