 of all kind and circumstance my ready into the hands of my
 dear friends and my body, I recommend to the hands to be
 buried in Christian or or, and as for my dear friends ready to be
 interred to be placed God to bless me with in this life
 and of all my lawful able to be paid and thus the last words I bequeath to
 my dear beloved wife Martha Perkins my land and house, fields and
 personal property and my legacy that my Cousin from my father
 estate in Virginia and my legacy that is Cousin from George Duke
 of her father's estate. I do truly will and bequeath all the above
 mentioned property to my wife Martha to possess and enjoy in peace
 during her natural life, my son, being Perkins is to have a house
 and Parson or his dollars when he calls for one and at her
 death all the property be appraised and equally divided among
 my dear childrens Elizabeth, Susan, Susannah, Martha, Mary
 Polly my daughter and son, and my Grand daughter to inherit
 and truly possess in peace and quietness - Now I do ratify
