I then the 2^d my Will and desire is that my brother William Thomas shall have one half of the money arising from the sale of my share of the land on which my mother now resides — also my bed and bedding and my trunks — I then the third my Will and desire is that my sister Mary Ann Thomas shall have all my wearing clothes I then the 4th my Will and desire is that my brother Samuel Thomas shall have all my tools and labor hired —
