In the Name of God Amen, I Robert Bowlin of the County of Mason and State of Kentucky, do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows, Nam I give and bequeath to my dear beloved wife Polly all my Estate during her natural life, except four hundred dollars worth of horses, which is my will, done that Thomas Price should have which I give and bequeath unto him, And after my wife's death it is my will and done, that my son Samuel Bowlin shall have two Mulatto, here named, Hemm and Dennis and the Balance of the whole of my Estate after all Just debts and paid and settling my two Children Samuel Bowlin and Nancy, shall be equally divided between my two Children Samuel and Nancy, The following Negroes to wit, Gato, Linn, Nino, Jara Paul, Hanna, they and their Increase Also Mitty, Joe George and Hemm and John Also my lands and all my other property that shall be left after my wife's death, Lastly I constitute and appoint my wife

47 Polly my Executor of this last will and Testament, it is my will and done that she shall not give security, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of June 1809.
