bed and Furniture for ever, Also I leave and bequeath unto
Margaret Lounsedale my Feather bed and Furniture for
ever And I do hereby Authorise and Impower and ap-
point Thomas Lounsedale and Simon Newton both of
Town of Washington County & State aforesaid to be
sole and whole Executors of this my last will and Tes-
tament and do hereby Revoke make void and disanul
all other Wills ever by me made sealed with my seal
