of white curtains her pair of sheets her County made Wood and Cotton Counter
pane or spread and one pair of Blankets and the whole to be her
Choice out of my beds and furniture. I also give and bequeath unto her

the same Mary Thoma Lupton the sum of One hundred Dollars in Cash
Hence Give and bequeath unto my Niece Polly M. Elam my Satten
Cloak

Hence I Give Bequeath all the rest and residue of my Estate of every
kind and Descriptions unto my beloved Grand children Thoma Drake
William Drake and Eliza Drake Children of Reuben Drake
Robert Taylor and John Drake Taylor sons of my Daughters
