I also give and bequeath unto my son Charles Maddox fifty Pounds to be paid to him after the Death or widowhood of my wife in horses, horned cattle and hogs to be Paid out of my Estate and also I further give and Bequeath unto my son Ezekiah Maddox and my Daughters Sarah and Martha Maddox all my household and Kitchen furniture together with all the stock and Plantation utensils after the Death ^{or} ~~of the~~ Widowhood of my said wife Violetta Maddox to be Equally Divided Between them. I also give and Bequeath unto my sons Natty Maddox, Townsend Maddox and my Daughter Elizabeth Lanhann one English shilling ^{a piece} to be Paid out of my Estate and I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Ezekiah Maddox to be my sole and sole Executor hereby revoking all other and former

Wills by me made. In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and ~~seal~~ ^{seal} this fourteenth day of January one Thousand Eight hundred and one.
