384 Court made at their February Term eighteen hun-
dred and fifteen we proceeded this eighth day of
March eighteen hundred and fifteen to lay off
the dower of Malinda Jefford in the land of her
late husband George Jefford and bounded as fol-
lows (to wit) Beginning at a buckeye and Su-
gar tree thence South Sixty poles to a white stone
and border thence west forty four poles to a
beech and sugar tree thence South seventy six West
one hundred and one poles to a stake in David Blaw-
chard's line thence with said line North five hun-
dred and thirty three West ninety four poles to a
stone in Major John Brown's line thence with said
line and passing his corner in all one hundred and
fifty three and three quarters poles to the Beginning.
Containing sixty seven acres.
