In the name of God Amen I Jacob Edwards
being sick and weak in body but of sound mind memory and
understanding and Conscious of the uncertainty of this
worldly life do make publish & Declare this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following
(First) I give and bequeath unto my dear beloved
daughter Elizabeth the plantation whereon I now dwell
containing one hundred and twelve acres surmounting
the natural top of the land & give called Cary
during her natural life also the whole of my household fur-
niture & stock of every kind during her Widowhood &
then to be equally divided amongst four children
to wit Sarah Emby, Milly, Mary and Alexander ~

Also I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Sarah Emby one
hundred acres of Land lying on the North of Licking river
and on a Bond from John Curtis assigned by John Harding
to her and her heirs and assigns forever.

Also I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Milly Edgery
whatever is recovered of William Wood & Arthur Fox concern-
ing a bond obtained of them for two hundred acres of Land
and that sum or sums of money obtained from the ap^o Wood
and Fox to be laid out in purchase of Land by my Executors
as for my two daughters aforesaid and to be equally divi-
ded between them & their heirs and assigns forever

Also I give and bequeath unto my dear beloved son Alexander four odd
lots adjoining the Town of Washington containing by Estima-
tion twenty acres and one Quarter of an acre to be sold by my
Executors after the crops are gathered in this present year also
the money arising from the sale of said Lots to be laid out in
Land and the said Land so purchased by my Executors to him his
heirs and assigns forever

Also I give and bequeath unto Sarah Srauth one hundred acres
of Land being a military survey located and surveyed by
John O'Banion lying about three miles up Three mile Creek
on the North side of the Ohio River nearly opposite to Limestone
to her & her heirs assigns forever

Also I desire my Executors to sell my Lot in Washington which
I purch^d of James Key likewise to sell and dispose of all my
Blacksmith tools to satisfy my Tripling and debts &c
