

In the name of God. I John B. Moore of Marion County and state of Kentucky being in a state of Imperfect health, but being in possession of my senses Do make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament as follows Viz

To my youngest son Mr. More I will and bequeath 1st the Legacy coming from the estate of my grand Father John Moore the exact sum I know not.

2nd The house hold furniture in the care of Joseph Moore with a request that he would give all to my eldest son but the bed which he may reserve for himself and sea Kettle for my said Eldest son.

3rd The money which was in the hands of my uncle William Reed Esq. Together with my horse saddle and clothing after my funeral and other necessary expenses are discharged.

In Witness of which I here set my hand and seal this fifteenth day of December Eighteen hundred & eleven.

1st The words from the estate of my Grandfather John Moore were intimated before the will was signed.

4th The Court held for Marion County the 9th day of December 1811. This last Will and Testament of John B. Moore Deceased was produced in Court and proved by the oath of Charles P. Smith Daniel Reese and James P. Lee Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

In obedience to an order of the Marion County Court the undersigned having met at the house of Judith Berry on the 19th day of October 1811 for the purpose of settling the estate of said John B. Moore and to divide the estate of Enock Berry deceased amongst the distributees of said Deceased proceeded as follows to wit

David to the said Judith Berry as part of her dower at the above valuation and there appears to be a balance of Twenty five Dollars a coming to said Judith to make her there part of the slaves		

Also be the undersigned have used our best endeavours to divide the balance of the above named negroes amongst the heirs of Enock Berry and find it out of our power to do so, to be divided to each distributee as there is seven heirs and but five slaves to divide amongst them and from information there appears to be but very little a coming from the sale of the personal Estate after the debts are paid. Given under our hands this day and date above written.
