28 Agreeable to an Order of the ^{monthly} ~~Board~~ Court of
 Mason County under the Act of Assembly of 1794
 entitled an Act to Ascertain the boundaries
 of Land and for other purposes we have
 proceeded to take the deposition of Jeremiah
 Washburn for the purpose of Establishing the
 boundary of the Land of Ignatius Mitchell
 of One thousand Acres that begins at the mouth
 of Lawrence's Creek & said Washburn being first
 sworn & then on his Oath doth say that in
 January 1786 that he with John Waller who
 he then understood to be a ~~deposed~~ Surveyor
 of then Fayette County did begin said
 Mitchell's Survey at the Mouth of Lawren-
 ce's Creek the deponent being one of the
 chain Men they did mound the said
 Creek up near ^{the} mouth of the big West
 fork to two Sugar trees and Buckeye on
 the bank of said Creek and being on the
 ground find one of said Sugar trees
 cut down the other two now standing
 from thence he thinks that they run
 about eleven Cuts from the before men-
 tioned corner trees into the hills he wher
 he sought to see Cornes on and Ash near a
 Mr. Flou & Saith on his Oath that he

29 doth believe that it is the corner of said Survey
 from the appearance of the lines marked to &
 from said tree from thence we went to the
 bank of the Ohio to the East corner being a
 Sugar tree & beech standing at a New York
 house which the deponent saith are the
 trees marked for said Mitchell's Survey &
 that ^{he} has frequently seen said trees since said
 Survey was made Question from Mr. Lee
 for Alexander Dorr did you trace the lines
 this day so that you was satisfied that was
 the line that you was with Waller & run for
 said Mitchell's Answer yes & the deponent
 further saith not March the 28th 1796
