Appigment of dower to Ann Curtis in the Estate of John Curtis deceased as follows to wit:

Agreeable to an order of the worshipful Court of Marion to us directed in the subscriber being duly sworn did proceed to allot the following parcel of land in addition to that part of land heretofore assigned to Ann Curtis as a part of her dower by former commissioners to wit. Beginning at a stake in the line of Clarke's preemption in the middle of the road where it crosses the west line of said preemption thence south seventy east along the said road twenty two poles to a stake thence South sixty poles along the orchard fence on the West side thereof to a stake in the south line of line of said deceased Curtis land which he purchased of Thomas Marshall thence west with said line to Clarke's Run thence up the said run with the meander thereof to two large trees on bank of said run corner to said land as purchased of said Marshall thence south eighty degrees East sixty poles to a beech marked A.C. thence south ninety eight poles to a white oak on the south side of said road thence North seventy East thirty one poles to the
