of and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and thereby be the better
prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence do
therefore make and Publish this my Last will & Testament in manner
& form following that is to say I first & principally I commit ^{my} Soul into the
hands of Almighty God & my body to the Earth to be decently Buried
at the discretion of my Executors herein after named and after my debts
and funeral Charges are paid I Give and bequeath to my Loving wife
Sabina Jones all my personal Estate to be at her disposal & also to possess &
enjoy all my plantation I now live on to farm & to plant as she shall live
her life time. All I Give & Devise to my Eldest Son William Jones one hundred
& fifty Acres of Land lying on the Meemee trace in Mason County him
Paying my Daughter Susanna Jones twenty Pounds in trade at the ex-
piration of Eleven years after this date & if he the said William Jones should
die without any heirs I Give the four mentioned land to my two Eldest Daugh-
ters Susanna & Sarah to be divided Share & Share alike. All I Give & Devise
to my two Youngest Sons Michael & Thomas all the rest & residue of my Land
to them after their Mothers death & to their heirs them Paying my two youngest
Daughters Sarah & Mary twenty Pounds each at the expiration of Eleven years
after this date to be paid in trade & if Michael or Thomas should die without
heirs I Give & Devise their part to Mary Jones my youngest Daughter and
Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my ~~son~~ wife Sabina
Jones to be sole Executor of this my Last Will & Testament

I recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it & my body I
recommend to the Earth to be buried in such decent Christian

63 like manner as my Executors hereafter named may judge most proper &
as touching my temporal Estate whereunto I have pleased God to bless
me in this life I give & bequeath in the following manner & form & In the
first place my desire is that all my just debts be paid I secondly give &
bequeath unto my Loving wife Elizabeth Stevens all my Estate both real
& Personal during her widowhood & after widowhood to be Equally divided
among my children when my youngest Child comes of Age & further that
she have the disposal of a certain Negroe named James as she shall think
Proper & in case her death should happen or she marry before my said young-
est Child comes of Age my desire is that my whole Estate should be kept together

for the support & Education of my youngest Children till the youngest comes of
Age & then to be Equally divided as above provided if any of my children should
die (die without heir or heirs lawfully begotten of their bodies then their parts
to return to the Estate & be Equally divided among the surviving Children

Lastly I constitute & appoint my Loving wife Elizabeth Stevens & my son in
Law Isaac White & my son Thomas Stevens my Executors & Executors In
a deed whereof I do acknowledge & take my last will & Testament sealed
with my seal & acknowledged this 17th Day of April 1791
