This day Robert Wilcox came before me and made oath that he did not bring into and bring two Negroes Slaves from the Islands to this State to evade the act of a Assembly entitled an act to prevent the farther importation of Slaves and that neither of them have been imported from Africa or any of the Islands since the Year One Thousand Seven hundred and Seven by Law but with an intention of Benefiting himself and family in this

I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth

Smart all my Estate both real and personal during her natural life I then I give and bequeath all and singular my Negroes Stock and household furniture after my wife deceases to be equally divided between my two Sons James Smart and Richard Smart and my two Daughters Eleanor Bennett Jane Ambler to them and their heirs forever except the Legacies hereafter mentioned I then I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son James Smart the two five acre Lots in the Town of Washington whereon I now live provided my beloved wife doth not sell the same during her life time to him and his heirs forever also one large feather bed and furniture and one new feather bed to my Daughter Eleanor and furniture I then I give and bequeath to my Son Richard Smart one Quarter Acre Lot with the buildings and Improvements thereon situated on the Main Street of the Town of Washington provided as in the last article the same is not sold during his mother's life to him and his heirs forever I then I give and bequeath unto my Grandson John (Pet. Aug. Negro given by name Van to him and his heirs forever I then I nominate my much beloved Son James Smart and my beloved Wife Elizabeth Smart Executors and Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament hereby two being all and singular Will or Wills heretofore by me made and establishing this my only true and genuine Last Will and Testament appointing my Executor and Executrix of names to be all my Just debts punctually paid and to receive in all that may be due to me at my decease before any the aforesaid divisions take place I then I give and bequeath unto my grandson Horatio Clift one Negro given by name Clary but in case he should die before he arrives at age the said Negro is to revert back

Smart all my Estate both real and personal during her natural life Item I give and bequeath all and singular my Negroes Stock and household furniture after my wives decease to be equally divided between my two Sons James Smart and Richard Smart and my two Daughters Eleanor Beny^t Jane Amblerston to them and their heirs forever except the Legacy hereafter mentioned Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son James Smart the two five acre Lots in the Town of Washington wherean I now live provided my beloved wife doth not sell the same during her life time to him and his heirs forever also one large feather bed and furniture and one new feather bed to my Daughter Eleanor and furniture Item I give and bequeath ^{up} ^{beloved} to my Son Richard Smart one Quarter Acre Lot with the buildings and Improvements thereon situated on the main Street of the Town of Washington provided as in the last article the same is not sold during his mother's life to him and his heirs forever Item I give and bequeath unto my Grandson John (Bek one Negro girl by name Van to him and his heirs forever Item I nominate my much beloved Son James Smart and my beloved Wife Elizabeth Smart Executors and Executrix of this my last Will and Testament hereby Revoking all and singular Will or Wills heretofore by me made and establishing this my only true and genuine last Will and Testament willing my Executor and Executrix of name to see all my Just debts punctually paid and to receive in all that may be due to me at my decease before any the foresaid divisions take place Item I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Horatio Clift one Negro girl by name Clary but in Case he should die before arrives at age the said Negroe is to revert back
