on a presumption. & assisted in carrying
the Chain to measure the same. That the
Surveyor Began at an Improvement where
~~there was~~ ^{then} some remains of ~~an~~ a Cabin which
the same place this day sworn to by the
Said Thomas Young & alluded to by his
