 Land left to his Mother and after her death the
 whole to be his Likewise will all the land that I
 now own on the North fork of Licking with the mill
 a saw mill and a grist mill to be sold and four hun-
 dred Pounds to be divided Between my Daughters
 fifty pounds to each one, and if there is any over-
 plus money after the Expenses is paid, for it to be
 divided equally amongst the Children to defray the
 expenses of their ~~at~~ schooling. Likewise all Bonds Notes
 or Book Accounts to be collected and after all expenses
 is discharged to be equally divided amongst the Children
 and I make and ordain these my two Brothers
 John Downing and Timothy Downing Executors of
 this my will to take Care and see the same perform-
 ed according to my true Intent and meaning In
 Witness whereof I the said Robert Downing have

to this my last will and Testament set my hand
 and seal this Sixteenth day of April One thousand
 eight hundred and two
