In the name of god Amen I Ralph Robinson of the County of Marion and State of Kentucky Yeoman Being weak of body But of Perfect mind and Memory being ⁱⁿ to mind the Immortality of my Body and knowing that It is appointed for all men once to die Do make this and Ordain this my Last will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all: my soul unto the Almighty that gave It and my body unto the earth to be Buried in a Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Executors and as Touching such worldly Estate whereinwith I am held and possessed Give Devise and Dispose of the same in Manner and form following To my true and loving wife Elizabeth I Bequeath all and singular my whole Estate Real and personal wholly to possess and hold the same to her only proper benefit and use untill my youngest Daughter Hannah be of the full age of Eighteen years then I do allow and require the whole of the Real and Personal Estate to be Divided

into three Equal shares and to be Disposed of in way following (Viz) one share to her (my said wife) her heirs and Assigns Executors or assigns forever and the other two shares to be Disposed amongst my following named Children Viz Mary Anne Elizabeth Samuel Sally Roughton William Ralph and Hannah each to have a full equal share of the said two third Parts. and further make constitute and Ordain my well beloved sons Richard and Thomas my sole Executors of this my Last will and Testament. and do hereby Revoke all and every other Testaments Wills Legacies or Bequests and Executors by me in any wise named Wills and Bequeathed and Ratifying and confirming this my last will and Testament and no other In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of March in the year one Thousand Eight hundred and one Signed sealed Published Pronounced and Declared by the said Ralph Robinson as his last will and Testament in presence of us who in his presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed
