And to him I will and bequeath the Sum of Forty pounds More on Account of his Indemnity to school and support him. Item I will that all the rents Issues and profits arising from my Estate Real and personal be reserved for the only benefit of Raising, Cloathing & schooling my Children till the youngest one come to the age of Eighteen years old and further I will that if any of the said Children should die before their full age their share shall be Equally divided among the surviving ones Equal and also I will that my beloved wife shall and may enjoy every thing Requisite And Every thing privilege as usual Untill her Death or second marriage & In Case of second marriage then does her privileges cease. Only I will that she shall have Horse saddle and bridle Bed and bedding and as much Household furniture as my Executors hereafter named shall think necessary. And I do hereby Appoint Matthew Ritchie & Craig Ritchie Both of Washington County and State aforesaid my lawful Executors of this my Last will and Testament And do Revoke all and every other will Hitherto made and declare

Which affidavit is taken for the purpose of Establishing the Beginning of Thomas Marshall's 1364 acre tract.

This Dependent being first sworn deposes and says that here the spot where we now are there once stood a large Hickory tree which tree stood near the head of a Spring emptying into a Branch of Francis Creek that then ^{have been} remains some of the timber which grew ^{there} on a Hickory tree that the land he stood near a Black ash marked TY an Iron wood marked WT. And another Iron wood marked FR and further this Dependent says not.
