Judy & Daniel also one Feather bed & Furniture
if Judy be set free then to a Negroe give to be made
out of my Estate to her & her Heirs forever
Item ^{my} will that my Executors may lay out a Town
at Canadas Bottom in a 1/4 of a mile and if they
cant make out payment without & part of my
Lick Land to be sold Item I will that my wife
have the use of all my Estate till my Children
is Raised then my son George Daniel Isaac
