George Wood and William Heddleston my Executors as Witness my hand and seal the day and date first above written

Duwall Deceased was Produced in court and Proved by the Oaths of Benjamin Bayles Charles Wood and Dolly Wood being thereunto and caused to be Recorded Sworn to by William Heddleston one of the Executors therein named who together with Thomas Marshall and Benjamin Bayles his securities entered into and acknowledged bond in the Penal of Three Thousand Pennas Current Money Conditions as the Law requires and upon his Motion Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form and liberty is Renewed to George Stockton and George Wood the other Executors therein named to join in the Probate when they shall think fit
