choice to be made by my Executors hereafter to be mentioned
my will also is that my wife my Daughter Polly and
Grandson Philip have their first, second, and third
choices of my cattle in the same manner that they bear
of my beasts, also my will is that my wife ^{and son} Elijah More
and my Daughter Polly divide my father's ^{and son} ~~beast~~ ^{estate}
between themselves and also the furniture of the house in the
next place I give fifteen hundred dollars to be raised out of my
estate to my son Scott More and his wife and all his children
to be equally divided between them etc. My will also is that
all the rest of my Estate that I have not given shall be divided
between my wife and all my children except Scott More
in the same manner it would be divided by Law, if I had
made no will And lastly I appoint Gabriel Houghton
my son William More and my son Elijah More Executors
of this my last Will and Testament and in witness hereof
