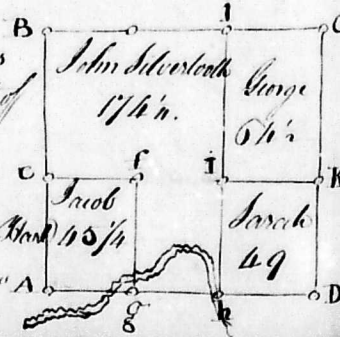

Silvertooth In conformity to an order of the worshipful court of
George County June 1805 we have now
commenced laid off and divided the lands of George
Silvertooth deceased amongst the heirs of said Decedent
as follows to wit,

We do let to John Silvertooth as
heir of said Decedent one lot of
49 acres together with two
other lots assigned him by
Polly Silvertooth (now Polly Wood) 150th
and Nancy Silvertooth (now
Nancy Polly) containing

in the whole 17 1/2 h. was bounded as follows to wit,
Beginning at the S to corner of the tract in Herbison
line at the letter B thence North 150 poles to two oaks
and sugar tree in chesters powder line at A thence S
198th 230 poles to sugar Bough and oak in
Stewarts line thence S 1/2 E 74 poles to sugar tree
iron wood and Elm in said line thence S 88th 2
92 poles to stake thence S 7th E 74 poles to two iron
woods and Dogwood in Herbison line thence S 87
to 100 poles to the Beginning

We also do let to George Silvertooth joint heir with
the above 6 1/2 acres Beginning at the letter C in
Powells line thence East 157 poles to about one
red oak as at B in Herbison line thence S 7th E 82 poles
to dogwood Hickory and sugar in John Silvertooths
line at I thence S 84th 132 poles to two oaks and
sugar tree in Powells line at A thence North 82 poles
to the Beginning

We also do let to Jacob Silvertooth joint heir with the
aforesaid 45th acres Beginning at or Hackberry &
Hickory as at A corner to Stewarts thence S 87th 109
poles to two Ironwoods and dogwood in Herbison
line as at C thence S 7th to 74 poles to stake in John
Silvertooths line as at E thence N 88th E 92 poles to a
sugar tree Iron wood and Elm in Stewarts line as at
G thence S 1/2 E 74 poles to the Beginning

We also do let to Sarah Silvertooth joint heir with
the above 49 acres of land Beginning at two sugar
trees in Stewarts line at D thence west 92 poles to about
