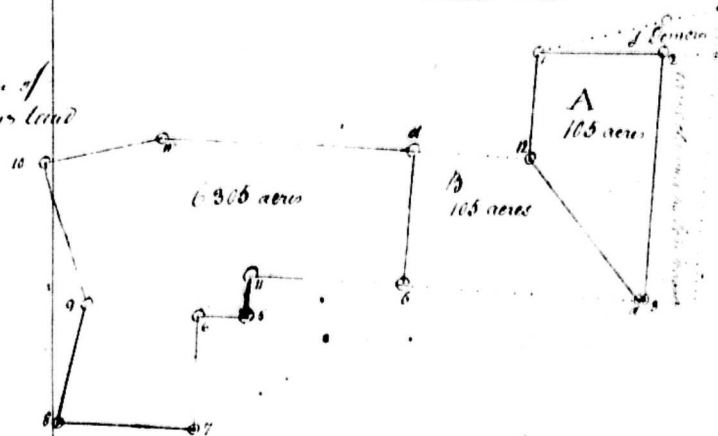

(I agreeably to an order of the Honorable Court of Merceer County made in January last and another this day made and to us directed, we the Subscribers have surveyed the Land of Abraham James Decedent lying in Merceer County on Harrods Run as shewed to us by Robert Mosby Executor of the said Decedent and find that the line as in the above plat designated by 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. 6. 7. 8. 9. 10. 11. 12 (being the Decedent's land free of interference from other claims) contains 366 acres. And the said Executor then produced an attested copy of the said Decedent's Will which devised to his son George James 300 acres of his said Land, in the south end of the survey, and to his two Daughters Sarah & Leah 200 acres in the other end to be equally divided between them which left 15 acres not devised to any person which said 15 acres the said

Executor directed us to divide equally amongst the said three children of the Decedent. We accordingly began at a stone in Potomac line 44th south of his North East corner at (a) and ran from thence East 113 poles to an Ash & Sugar sapling in Division line at (b) leaving to George James 300 acres assigned in the foregoing plat by the Will. We then began at an Ash & Elm sapling in Indiana line at (c) and ran S. 11th West 300 poles to a hickory cut & corner North East corner at (d) leaving to Sarah his wife 100 acres it being the lot in the foregoing plat marked A. & then to Leah James 100 acres it being the lot marked B) leaving back to the division line as between Sarah & Leah due regard to quality improvement & form as well as of quality given under our hand this 27th April 1805 Thomas Freeman Correl Parker the Clerk
