

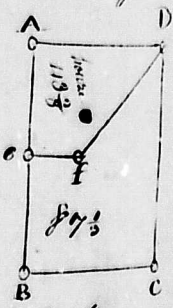

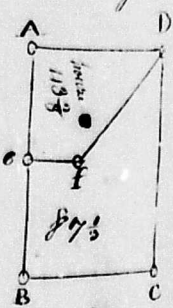

In conformity to an order of the worshipful Court of Mercer County we have laid off and assigned to Elizabeth late widow of Joseph Cole Deceased her right of Dower We assign to her one Negro man Tapp value to 400 and a Negro woman. Value at 235. 33 and one negro girl Sileny at 150 in slaves. We also lay off and assign to her 113 1/2 acres of Land including the Dwelling house of said Deceased being one third part of the Tract of which said Deceased possessed at his Decease (to wit) Beginning at a Buck and Sugar as at A in Robert Mathers line; thence North 92 poles to three Buckes as at C in Jennetts Langes line thence West 140 poles to a large stump in the field as at E thence S 35 W 120 poles to an Hackberry and buckeye corner to Jacob Whoberry as at D thence East 112 poles to the Beginning. We also allot to said Elizabeth 5 1/2 out of the amount
