Item the residue of my estate of every sort after paying off the Special Legacies herein before mentioned including all now in my possession in the possession of Rob. Atterby Esq. & in the possession of my Brother Joseph Lewis I have to be equally divided among all my children or their legal heirs. In the name of God amen I Peter Jordan of the County of Mercer and State of Kentucky being very sick and weak in body and of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God willing unto mine the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the ascension of my Creator nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give Devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form first I give and bequeath unto Gerace Jordan and John Jordan my grandsons they two being Patrick Jordan son the half of the land which Patrick Jordan now lives upon to enclose the plantation Patrick Jordan now lives on also Gerace and John Jordan above mentioned is not to disinherit their father Patrick Jordan but let him have the privilege of living on the plantation as long as he shall so prefer and raise such produce as he shall so prefer on the plantation also Gerace and John Jordan shall pay their Brother Peter Jordan ten pounds each in property within the term of two years Also I give to my well beloved son Peter Jordan and

In the name of God amen I Jeremiah Philips of the County of Mercer and State of Kentucky being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God for the same do make publish and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit I give unto my well beloved Wife Matting Philips during her life or Widowhood my Negroes George Peter Jimmy Casney Franky Sam Sany & Dick together with all my household and Kitchen furniture and moveable effects also two hundred and thirty acres of Land including the plantation whereon I live with all its appurtenances to her freely to be possessed and enjoyed during her life or Widowhood also her choice of live of my horse harts also six of my cattle which ever she may choose also my Will and desire is that she may have all my Stock of Sheep and Dogs all the above articles I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife during her life or Widowhood I also give and bequeath to my well beloved son George Philips one negro woman named ~~Abbe~~ which he has now in his possession also one hundred and fifteen acres of Land it being part of the tract I now live on and where he has made his improvement with all my wearing cloaths and Gen by him to be freely possessed forever Also my Will and desire is that my well beloved son William Philips have one Negro Woman named Dinah which he has now in his possession also one hundred
