 once to die - Do make and enact this to be my
 last will and Testament, that is to say principally
 and first of all I give and recommend my soul

 cutors, nothing doubting but at the general resurrec-

 all my just debts be first paid; then I give and

 about two hundred and sixty acres I give and
 bequeath unto my dearly beloved children namely
 Mary & Samuel to be divided equal in quality &
 quantity according unto my wife Jane the full use and

293 benefit of the house and plantation a heron I now live during her natural life; and after she has at her discretion made use of all the property I gave her to the support of her and the children if there should be any left at her death for it to be equally divided between my beloved children and if my wife should now be with child for that child to have an equal part with the rest of my children. I do appoint I desire that my friends John Adams and Henry Thompson should be the Executors of this my last will and Testament, and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and annul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, Covenants and bequeaths or Executors by me named written or bequeathed, ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 6 day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine.
